

Karl-Heinz Stiller began working at Nixdorf Computer AG in 1966. He held various management posts in the development and production fields before assuming responsibility for worldwide manufacturing in 1985. One year later, he was appointed to the divisional board of management.

With the founding of Siemens Nixdorf Informationssysteme AG (SNI) in 1990, Stiller took on worldwide business responsibility for banking self-service systems and also, in 1993, for international retail business. Early in 1995, he was appointed to senior management at Siemens Nixdorf Informationssysteme AG and, in 1998, became Chief Executive Officer of the newly founded Siemens Nixdorf Retail and Banking Systems GmbH. Following this, from October 1999 to May 2004, Stiller was President and CEO of Wincor Nixdorf Holding GmbH.

Upon the company's stock flotation in May 2004, he was appointed President and CEO of Wincor Nixdorf AG.

At the end of February 2007 he stepped down as President and CEO, becoming Chairman of the Supervisory Boards of Wincor Nixdorf AG and Wincor Nixdorf International GmbH, Paderborn.
